




Kurapia is a newly developed, highly versatile groundcover.

Once established, this versatile turf-alternative requires little maintenance and needs less water than cool season turfgrass. Kurapia grows close to the ground, rarely exceeding three inches in height. If left un-mowed, the plant becomes covered in small white, sterile flowers in Spring and Summer. Kurapia is found to be highly tolerant of saline, acidic and basic soils. Its deep, mat-like root zone also helps with slope stabilization and soil erosion. Kurapia is not recommended for sports fields or heavy traffic areas.



Features and Benefits

Color

- Dark green all year with small white flowers May-October

Low Water Use

- Once established can be irrigated at 20% evapotranspiration by drip irrigation and 40% evapotranspiration with overhead irrigation
- Kurapia has a WUCOLS factor of .4

Low maintenance

- Establishes quickly (March-September), and its prostrate growth habit reduces the need for pruning

Tolerates a Wide Range of pH and High Salinity

- Grows well in both low and high pH soils and tolerates soils containing high salt concentration

Rapid Establishment

- Rapid growth rate and establishes itself quickly
- Resilience after drought stress and mechanical damage

Erosion Control

- Has an extensive root system, and depending on soil type, can reach a depth of nearly 6'
- Vast, mat-like root system reduces soil erosion and water runoff



Low weed invasion

- Has a thick, dense growth that suppresses weeds

Does Not Reseed

- Bred to be sterile, preventing undesirable spreading by reseeding

Long Flowering Season

- Has a long bloom period with flowers that attract pollinators such as bees and butterflies

Climate

- Can survive in temperatures from 40-120 degrees F
- USDA zones 7b-13b

Shade Tolerant

- Full sun to part shade

Width

- Spreading Plant
